**How does the
Snow-JahZee™
work?**



Every rider gets a card like this:

Judged Runs



Rules:

- The competitors ride a line of three kickers (16m, 15m & 22m)
- Every Rider can do 8 judged runs (= 24 jumps), which count for the ranking
- In between judged runs the competitors are allowed to do as many training runs as they like
- To do a judged run, a rider has to tell the starter to mark a “Judged Runs”-field on his Snow-JahZee™-card.
- The judges decide whether a trick is considered as landed or not (clean execution and board must be grabbed)
- After a judged run the rider passes the check-point, where landed tricks are marked on his Snow-JahZee™-card
- Every trick can only be marked once on a Snow-JahZee™-card, but the same trick can be attempted several times if not landed
- Every landed trick is worth an assigned number of points – the rider with the most points wins the Snow-JahZee™
- Still there is no losers at the Snow-JahZee™: “Combo-prices” can be won too!



EXAMPLE: 1st run

Rider "John Doe" has just done his first judged run. He stuck all 3 jumps (fs 540°, sw fs 180° and bs 900°). His personal Snow-JahZee™ card now looks like this:

EXAMPLE: 2nd run

John did his second run, but unfortunately he bailed a sw fs 360° on the first kicker and a backflip on the second kicker, therefore only one jump (bs 360°) is counted as landed for this run:

EXAMPLE: In the meantime John has finished his 8 judged runs (24 jumps), but unfortunately he either bailed 8 times or didn't execute them cleanly enough. John gets a total of 73 points. If no one else has more points, he will win the Snow-JahZee! Congratulations!
